Share Offerings and Prices

We will provide you and your family fresh produce directly from our farm from roughly the 3rd week of May through the last week of August (16 weeks). We will gladly accept payment by credit card.

Full share -- \$450 (\$425 if paid in full by February 15, 2016)

Consists of about a half-bushel of 6 to 12 different items of fresh produce
 I choose to pay the full amount of \$450 (or \$425, if applicable)
 I choose to pay in 2 installments of \$225 now and \$225 on or before May 15

Egg share -- \$50 (limited number available)

Consists of a half-dozen per week. This fee will basically buy feed for one hen and the eggs the bird lays for the season. Birds will be allowed to graze outside and be given supplemental feed as needed.

Half share -- \$250 (\$225 if paid in full by February 15, 2016)

Consists of about half of a full share with the same variety of fruits & vegetables each week
 I choose to pay the full amount of \$250 (or \$225, if applicable)
 I choose to pay in 2 installments of \$125 now and \$125 on or before May 15

So you have the utmost confidence in the fruits and vegetables that we grow, we invite you to pick up your share at our farm. However, we realize that it may be more convenient for you to pick up in Somerset.

OUR PLEDGE TO YOU

We pledge to grow your fruits and vegetables using sustainable methods, employing the use of IPM (integrated pest management).

We pledge to do our best to provide you with 16 weeks of fresh produce from our farm starting (approximately) the week of May 12 through the last week in August 2016.

We pledge to harvest your produce in a timely way, wash, and handle the produce using good agricultural practices (GAP) to minimize any risk of contamination.

We pledge to have your shares ready for pick up at the agreed time and location.

WHAT WE EXPECT OF YOU

We expect shares to be picked up by you or a designee (let us know prior to pick up if someone other than you will be picking up your share) at the assigned place and time. Shares not claimed will be donated to a local shelter if possible.

We expect understanding when/if crop failures occur. You share in both crop successes and failures.

We expect feedback – both good and bad – as this is a very different way to market produce.
